I hope that this communication finds you and your family healthy and safe.

As we turn the calendar to March 2021, Greenwood students can expect to be outside more, enjoying the fresh air and sun. As of March 1, all K-5 hybrid students will line up outside on the playground each morning. Students must report to their assigned location along the fence until 8:45 a.m. Students will be picked up from the same, spaced-apart location along the fence, away from the building, at 3:35 p.m. Grades K-3 line up along the playground/Ward Avenue fence, Grades 4 and 5 line up along the Greenwood Avenue fence. We will not line up near the school building until September. Classroom breaks and recess will be held outside. In truly warm weather, expect students to eat lunch outside and experience outdoor classroom lessons.
